-A renewal quote for the Borough's Property and Workers Compensation Insurance was received from First National Insurance Agency, LLC. The Property Insurance increased by \$1,045 and the Workers Compensation by \$3,951.

-Mr. Trombetto said that he has not received a counteroffer from the Public Works Department regarding their contract as of today.
