



-The Secretary explained that the backup generator at the Municipal Building is still not working. There was a power outage last week and the generator did not kick on. It was found to be unplugged. She said that she did not know why it was unplugged or who did this but it needed to be fixed. It never was properly fixed to make it work the way it should be. Council asked her to have the Public Works plug the unit back in and if power goes out again then it will have to be manually shut off once power is back on. They also asked her to get the factory number for the unit and call them and set up an appointment to have them come and fix the unit.

-President Sobolosky informed Council that he had spoken with Mr. Bassar earlier today regarding the storm drain easement issue on Miller Street. Mr. Bassar said that he was willing to sign the agreement but that he received a letter from the Solicitor which wasn't a very nice one and referred to the Borough taking his land. President Sobolosky had the Secretary recopy the letters which Mr. Bassar was sent so that he could review them to find out if what Mr. Bassar was saying was true. He did not see anything in the second letter that made any reference to taking his land or any other thing. He will set up meeting with Mr. Bassar to discuss this.

-Council asked the Secretary to send letters to those committee members whose terms are up this year and see if they would like to be re-appointed to their respective committees.

-The Secretary informed Council that the Re-organization meeting for the year 2016 is to be held on Monday, January 4<sup>th</sup>. She said that Council can determine what time they want to hold this meeting. Council decided on 6:30pm.

A motion was made by Vidovich seconded by DeDominicis and carried to advertise the Re-organization Meeting for Monday, January 4, 2016 at 6:30pm at the Fire Department Banquet Hall, 900 S. Gross Street, Conway, PA 15027.

President Sobolosky read the notes at the bottom of the agenda.

A motion was made by Bohach seconded by DeDominicis and carried to go into Executive Session to discuss possible litigation issue involving Norfolk Southern and the Pretreatment bill at 7:36 pm.

The meeting was resumed at 7:59 pm.

No action was taken.
