

-The Secretary explained that the current Health Officer had resigned. The Borough needs to appoint someone to take his place. She had contacted the Department of Health to see if there was anybody that they recommended. They did not recommend anybody but did put out an email to all certified Health Officers to contact the Borough if they would be interested in working for the Borough. Mr. Nicholas Sheleheda, the current Health Officer for the Borough of Ambridge, contacted the office and said that he would be willing to work for the Borough. The Secretary informed him that the Borough does not charge a fee for this and that the former Health Officer charged \$50 per inspection, the Borough paid him this amount and then charged the institution the same to get their license. Vice-President Sobolosky asked if the fee would be the same. The Secretary said that she thought so but that she would check on this,

A motion was made by Trombetta seconded by Bohach and carried to appoint Mr. Nicholas Sheleheda as the Health Officer for the Borough and to follow the same procedure for inspections and issuance of licenses as was done with the previous Health Officer.

The Secretary stated that she was given different times for the party so she was not sure what the actual time was but that she knew it started at 2. Mr. Skocich said that the Recreation Department is looking for another Santa to ride on the Fire Truck. Mr. Andreno, a fireman, stated that this was discussed at last night's Fire Department meeting and someone had volunteered to do this at that meeting.

Mr. Bohach said that he was done reviewing the bills. He asked what the bill from H&H Industries was. Vice-President Sobolosky said that these were high efficiency light bulbs for the municipal building. The Secretary confirmed that this is what it was for. Mr. Bohach said that the bills were okay then and could be placed on the Regular Meetings Agenda for approval.

A motion was made by Trombetta seconded by Skocich and carried to adjourn at 7:30 pm.
